Junior **Adam Ruszkowski**, nicknamed Haven, broke the school record for wins since reinstatement with a brilliant eight-inning effort against Toledo for his ninth career win. Ruszkowski pitched eight innings allowing one run on 10 hits and a walk. The 6-4, 235-pounder left eight Rockets stranded and got two double plays in the game. He left three runners stranded on third, all the while protecting a lead that was at most two runs during seven of his eight innings. He tied the school record with on March 16 against Loyola (New Orleans), as he pitched seven innings, allowing four hits and one run as the Bulls won, 12-4. He is just one wins away from becoming just the 14th pitcher in school history to reach 10 career wins.

- Under second-year head coach **Mike McRae**, the Griffis are out to an 8-22 start with a 2-7 mark in the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference.
- The Griffis are led by senior **Matt Mazurek**, who is hitting .358 with a homer and 22 RBIs. He also leads the team with 12 stolen bases.
- Senior **Kevin Smith** is leading the Griffis with four home runs while his .337 average is second on the squad.
- Senior **John Axford** tossed Canisius' first shutout since 2002 on Sunday, as he two-hit Iona, leading the Griffis to a 10-0 win.



## Western Michigan at a glance

- The Broncos are off to a 15-12 start with a 4-5 MAC record after sweeping Akron in a three-game set last weekend.
- Freshman **Ethan Hollingsworth** struck out a career best 12 batters in Western Michigan's 8-2 win at Akron to earn MAC West Division Pitcher of the Week. The true freshman threw seven and a half innings giving up only two runs off five hits.
- Western Michigan is leading the MAC in ERA, with a 3.71 team ERA, led by junior **Dan O'Brien's** 2.47 ERA. The hurler has a 3-2 record in 47.1 innings while Hollingsworth and senior **Mark Rasmussen** also rank in the top 20 in the conference in ERA.



against MAC playoff hopeful Toledo on Apr. 8-9, as he went 5-for-13 with four runs, two doubles, a homer, two RBIs and a hefty slugging percentage of .769. He had a hit in all three contests and in Saturday's 4-1 win, he scored twice, including the go-ahead run after doubling in the third inning. In Sunday's game, he went 3-for-5 to spark Buffalo's offense to the 11-3 win, as he hit a homer to cut Toledo's lead to 2-1 in the first inning, then was apart of back-to-back-to-back doubles in the second inning that helped put UB in the driver's seat. He also lifted his season average from .202 to .223 during the week.

### MERZ'S MERCY

Redshirt freshman **Eric Mruczek** broke into the lineup on Saturday at Toledo for just his fourth career start for the Bulls in the first game of Saturday's doubleheader, got a hit and stuck in the lineup for the series against

the Rockets, going 5-for-11 with a run and two RBIs.

### ROCKETING PAST TOLEDO

Buffalo won its first series ever against Toledo, winning 4-1 in the first game of a doubleheader on Apr. 8 and taking Sunday's rubber match on Apr. 9, 11-3, taking two of three from the Rockets after dropping two of three in 2004 and 2005.

### HIT PARADE

Buffalo's 16 hits in Sunday's 11-3 win against Toledo were the most the team has put on the board in a conference game since posting 16 in a 12-8 loss to Miami (OH) on Apr. 18, 2003.

ERA in 27 innings. The starting three pitchers allowed a grand total of five runs in 22.1 innings, as junior **Adam Ruszkowski** allowed a run in eight innings of work and sophomore **Shane Wolf** allowed two runs in 7.1 innings on Saturday. Senior **Sean McWilliams** allowed two runs in seven frames on Sunday.

### LEFTY KING

Senior **James Kingsley** continued to mash the ball against left-handed pitching, as he went 5-for-11 with two runs, a triple and two RBIs against Toledo, which features three southpaw starters. He is hitting .379 (11-for-29) against lefties this year.

### FRESHMAN FIREMAN

Freshman **Steve Geltz** had an impressive debut for the Bulls, as he earned his first collegiate save by striking out two, including the game-ender in Buffalo's 4-2 win at Appalachian State. His next save opportunity looked even better, as he struck out the side on March 3 in an 8-7 win against Marshall. His third save opportunity looked much the same, as he struck out the side, walking one against Toledo on Apr. 8. Geltz is currently tied for sixth in the conference in saves with three.

### DOUBLE THE FUN

Senior **James Kingsley** set the school record for career doubles with the 40th of his career in the seventh inning of Buffalo's 11-3 win against Canisius on Mar. 29. He passed Brandon DiCesare's mark set from 2000-03. Kingsley already held the school record for doubles in a season, as he blasted 20 as a sophomore in 2003.

### HITTING 100

Sophomore **Mike Folli**, a Wallace Watch candidate, is just five hits away from becoming just the 10th player since the program was reinstated to reach 100 career hits. The Louisville Slugger/*Collegiate Baseball* candidate is tied for the team lead with 31 hits after leading the Bulls with a .348 average and 64 hits as a freshman.

### MISSING 100

Senior **Sean McWilliams** became the sixth pitcher since UB reinstated baseball in 2000 to reach 100 career strikeouts when he k'd Canisius' John Papierski looking with a fastball at the knees during his 11-3 win on Mar. 29. McWilliams, who has added eight strikeouts since, is just 11 strikeouts from entering the top 10 in UB's career history.

### AQUILA'S AQUA

Senior **Carl Aquila** has made an immediate impact with the Bulls after his

circuitous route to Amherst, scoring the game-winning run in Feb. 19's 4-2 win against Appalachian State. Coming from Buffalo parochial school St. Mary's, Aquila was a star at Erie Community College before spending a year at NAIA school Bellevue University. During the week of Mar. 28, the outfielder snapped an 0-for-16 slump by going 6-for-17 (.352) with two runs, a double and an RBI. He is currently second on the team with a .297 average (30-for-101) and seven doubles.

### AT HOME AWAY FROM HOME

The Bulls have taken a liking to Canisius' Demske Sports Complex, as it has scored 31 runs in the last three games played on the artificial turf off Main Street. Buffalo posted a 16-0 rout on Apr. 6, 2005, featuring two home runs from **James Kingsley**, before dropping the second game of the doubleheader, 8-4. Coming back on Mar. 29 this year, the Bulls once again put on their rally caps, posting an 11-3 win that featured four home runs. Freshman **James Piazza** blasted his first career homer along with shots from freshman **Brad Agustin**, senior **David Amaro** and Kingsley. The Bulls are 15-6 against Canisius since the program was reinstated in 2000.

### A NOTE FROM THE BULLPEN

The Buffalo pitching staff seems to have turned the corner after allowing 14 earned runs on Mar. 18 at New Orleans to raise the team ERA to 9.13 for the season. In the ensuing 11 games, the Bulls' hurlers have given up 41 earned runs for an ERA of 3.88 and have dropped the season ERA to 6.97. Although the Bulls have the highest overall ERA in the MAC, their 3.69 ERA in conference play is third.

### DAN THE MAN

Junior catcher **Dan Quinn** woke up after struggling in the first two series, as he went 16-for-41 (.390) with four home runs, eight runs and 12 RBIs in the next 13 games. His home run in the eighth inning on Mar. 3 was the game-winner for the Bulls while his two-run shot on Mar. 5 brought the Bulls within one run in the fifth inning. The backstop is third on the Bulls with a .284 average and is second with a .477 slugging percentage. He is tied for sixth in the conference with four homers.

### THE EXTRA BASE

Sophomore **Mike Folli** leads the Mid-American Conference in triples (3) and is tied for third in the MAC in doubles (9). The second baseman is second on the team with 49 total bases, and a .471 slugging percentage. He leads the team with a .298 average.

## A WOLF AT THE DOOR

Sophomore **Shane Wolf** may have not turned heads yet in the Mid-American Conference, but it seems like the time is drawing near. In eight starts this year, the 6-2, 210-pound southpaw has lasted at least five innings six times, plus his versatility has allowed him to pitch out of the bullpen three times. Although he has a 5.13 ERA, he ranks ninth in the MAC in innings pitched (47.1) and tenth in strikeouts (42). In his last three starts, he has lasted 18.2 innings and allowed just six earned runs. He has struck out 16 and walked five, but has only three losses to show for it. He has struck out a team-high seven twice this season, including on March 26 against Central Michigan.

## (RE)APPEARING

Senior **Sean McWilliams** is just three appearances away from tying Mark McMahon's program record of 52 career appearances, set from 2000-03. Amazingly, McWilliams has a chance to break the mark in only three seasons with the blue-and-white, as he spent his freshman season at Mercyhurst College, a Division II school in Erie, PA. McWilliams is tied for ninth in the MAC with 12 appearances this season.

## JOHNS ON THE SPOT

Senior **Matt Johnson** strung together two solid starts in a row, after allowing nine hits and four earned runs in a 5-3 loss to Southeastern Louisiana on Mar. 15, he gave up six hits and one earned run in a six-inning stint in a 5-0 loss to Central Michigan on Mar. 26. ## FRESHMEN?

Freshmen **James Piazza** and **Jacob Rosenbeck** were the only players to get hits for the Bulls during their Mar. 25 doubleheader with Central Michigan. Piazza and Rosenbeck each had a single in each game, both two-hit shutouts for the Chippewas.

## BACK IN THE FOLD

After being hit on the wrist with a pitch at Southern Miss on March 10, sophomore **Mike Folli** missed three games. Upon returning to lineup on Mar. 15, he went 0-for-4, but in the next four games, the 2005 Louisville Slugger/*Collegiate Baseball* Freshman All-American has returned to form, going 8-for-19 with five runs and two RBIs, smacking two doubles and a triple in the next four games. He also moved back to his freshman position of second base and made just one error in 31 chances (.968) in the remainder of the Southern Spring Break trip.

## FOLLI'S FILE

It's not just **Mike Folli** who has a bat that is starting to heat up. Fraternal twin, **E.J. Folli**, went 3-for-4 with a run on March 19. He also had a pinch-hit on March 18, bringing his average all the way up from .167 to its current .269 (7-for-26). Folli has found time mainly at designated hitter, but can also play in the outfield. In 32 at bats this season, E.J. has come up with runners on base 22 times and has hit .400 (4-for-10) with runners in scoring position, the highest mark on the team.

## POWER UP

After going the first five games without a home run, the University at Buffalo baseball team found Marshall's University Heights Field to be a happy hunting ground, blasting five homers in the four-game set, with junior **Dan Quinn** leading the way with two home runs. Freshmen **Jacob Rosenbeck** and **Brad Agustin** each hit their first career home runs and sophomore **Mike Folli** also added his first bomb of the season. In the ensuing eight games during the southern road swing, the Bulls hit seven homers.

## STAGGERING STATS

Senior **Sean McWilliams** was on fire since after allowing nine runs in his first 7 2/3 innings last year. In the ensuing 53 1/3 innings, McWilliams allowed just nine runs, for a meager ERA of 2.02 before allowing nine earned runs against Southern Miss on Mar. 11.

## GETTING THE POP BACK

After opening the season with an 0-for-6 series against Appalachian State, senior **David Amaro** broke out to the tune of a 6-for-14 (.429), three-game set at Maryland-Eastern Shore. The senior posted two doubles for a slugging percentage of (.571) and his 4-for-5 performance in the second game of a doubleheader paced the Bulls to an 11-3 win. He also picked up two RBIs with a single in the first inning and a double in the third, pacing the win. Amaro reached 100 career hits, becoming just the ninth player since UB reinstated baseball to reach the plateau, singling on Mar. 17 against New Orleans.

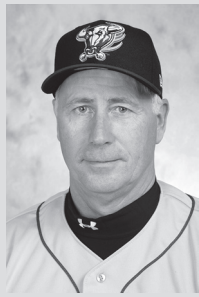
## NOWAK'S KNOCKS

#### ON THE WATCH

Sophomore shortstop **Mike Folli** is one of only two Mid-American Conference players on the preseason College Baseball Foundation's Wallace Watch, along with 119 others around the nation. The Brooks Wallace Award is given to the top collegiate baseball player in the country each season.

#### SHUT DOWN

Central Michigan's back-to-back-to-back shutouts of Buffalo was the first time in the 46-year history of the program that the Bulls had been shut out three times in a row. Eastern Michigan also threw a shutout in the Bulls' next conference game, the first time the team was ever shut out four times in a row in league play.

#### A FRESHMAN PHENOM

**Mike Folli** had a year to remember in 2005, as the 5-10, 175-pound infielder hit a stellar .348, embarking on a school-record 22-game hitting streak and earning Louisville Slugger/Collegiate Baseball Freshman All-American honors. He also became the first UB player to earn Mid-American Conference All-Star honors, as he was a second-team utility selection.

#### JUST A SAVE AWAY

Senior **Sean McWilliams** enters the 2006 season just one save away from breaking the school's all-time record. Currently, his six saves ties him with Bill Casbolt (1974-77) and Bill Riedel (1973-76).

#### RUN AND GET GUNNED

**Dan Quinn** established himself as a legitimate Division I catcher in 2005, as he posted a .256 average while finishing second on the team with seven homers and 30 RBIs. More impressive was his work behind the plate, where the junior gunned down 29 runners in 41 stolen base attempts.

#### A CENTURY IN THE MAKING

With the wins last weekend, head coach Bill Breene is just four wins shy of becoming the third coach in school history to reach 100 career wins.

#### GET YOUR PROGRAM

With four position starters and two pitchers leaving to graduation, five letterwinners not returning to the team and two starting pitchers out with medical redshirts, the 2006 Buffalo Bulls are flux with newcomers. Thanks to a deep recruiting class culled mainly from the ranks of Section VI, the Bulls do not look so

unfamiliar to the region's baseball fans. Led by infield freshmen **Brad Agustin** (2b) and **Jacob Rosenbeck** (3b), the Bulls have a distinctly young look.

#### A LOCAL FLAVOR

The 2006 Bulls will have a very distinctive Buffalo flavor, as head coach Bill Breene has recruited six First Team *Buffalo News* All-Western New York high school selections, including **Brad Agustin**, **Jacob Rosenbeck**, **Charles Karstedt**, **James Piazza**, **Frank Jagoda** and **Steve Geltz**.

#### BROTHERS IN ARMS

The 2006 Bulls have two sets of brothers on the roster, with redshirt sophomore **Joe Rosenbeck** being joined on the team by freshman third baseman **Jacob Rosenbeck**. Ironically, it will be both players first year on the active roster, as arm injuries have kept Joe from the mound the past two seasons.

The brothers compliment sophomore twins **Mike** and **E.J. Folli**. The Folli brothers have both fit right into the fold at UB, with Mike becoming a Freshman All-American and the team's MVP in his first year while E.J. earned the team's Coaches' Award.

**Trevor Blair**, a freshman on the squad, comes to UB just four seasons after his brother, Corey, graduated after playing two seasons under coach Breene.

Sophomore **Kevin Nowak** also has brotherly ties in Division I baseball, with his brother, Jeremy, signing a letter of intent to attend Stony Brook in the fall.

#### A LONG WAY FROM HOME

The Bulls opened their season with 18 games on the road, as the 29-day sojourn took them through five states and to eight different opponents during the southern swing. Included in the mix were sets with Conference USA members Marshall and Southern Mississippi. The Bulls have only 18 of their 56 scheduled games scheduled for the friendly confines of Amherst Audubon Field.

#### SUMMER STARS

Junior catcher **Dan Quinn** and sophomore shortstop **Mike Folli** were both honored by their summer leagues, with each earning all-star honors.

Quinn, a member of the Northwoods League's Brainerd Blue Thunder, hit .277 while appearing in 59 of Brainerd's 67 games, blasting a team-high 16 doubles. He also tied for the team lead with five round-trippers and was second on the squad with 27 RBIs. He also stole seven bases in 10 attempts and helped guide the pitching staff to eight shutouts.

Copperheads, Folli hit .259 with six doubles, 16 RBIs and 10 stolen bases while playing in all 42 games. He led the Copperheads in hits (42) and also added 12 runs. In the field, Folli played primarily second base while also starting 10 games at his natural position of shortstop, making just four errors in 176 chances.

## IN THE PROS

**Joe Mihalics '05** became the first UB baseball player since 1987 to enter professional baseball when he was drafted in the 34th round by the New York Mets in June. The shortstop set UB career records in hits (234) and runs (136). He also set the single-season record for hits (76) as a junior. In 2005, he played for both Class A-Mets affiliates Brooklyn and Hagerstown. This summer, Mihalics will play with the New Jersey Jackals of the Can-Am Independent League.

## HURTING

Buffalo is without two of its top pitchers this season, thanks to injury. Sophomore **Tony Kurtz**, who set a program record since reinstatement with six wins in 2005, will be out with a forearm injury this year. Junior **Mark Tourangeau**, a 2004 draft pick by the Seattle Mariners, is out while recovering from Tommy John surgery.

## LOOKING AHEAD

Heading the Buffalo's class of 2010 recruits are three recruits from Ohio, the heart of the MAC with six of the conference's 12 schools, including left-handed pitcher **RL Eisenbach**, right-handed pitcher and first baseman **Kori Korenek** and outfielder **Bobby Pizzuto**. Buffalo also signed **Shivam Bhan** and two early-period signees from New York, right-handed pitcher **Jeff Hains** and outfielder **Adam Skonieczki**. Eisenbach was a Puma All-American last season, and at the All-American combine this year, his curveball and his control was rated second best in the camp.

## FOR THE TEAM

The 2005 Bulls did not set any program records in any offensive or pitching categories, but it still set a school record since the team was reinstated in 2000 with its 19 wins. It also became the first team to complete a sweep of a MAC opponent since joining the league with its season-ending sweep of Marshall.

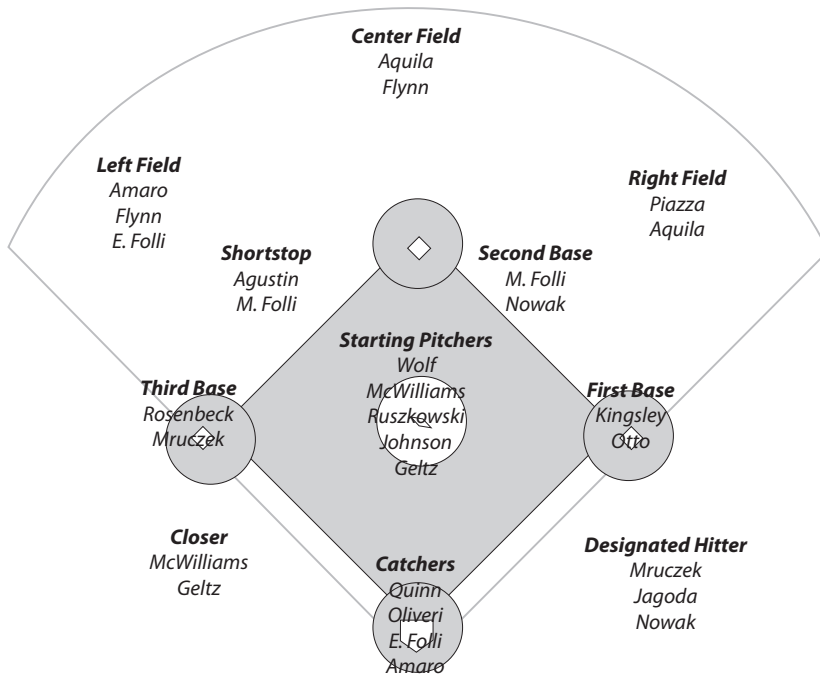
