	Task	Deadline
<input type="checkbox"/>	Apply online to UB—everyone must pay the application fee unless your guidance office verifies you are eligible for a fee waiver. http://admissions.buffalo.edu/apply/index.php	Preferably by December 1 st , but no later than 4 weeks after you commit or sign with UB
<input type="checkbox"/>	File your application for financial aid—this is the only way to get loans and federal grants. www.fafsa.gov *Be sure you send your FAFSA information to UB—our code is 002837.	Anytime during the spring of your senior year—this is EXTREMELY important. Everyone should file a FAFSA.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Send your OFFICIAL high school transcripts and your SAT and/or ACT scores to the UB Admissions Office or directly to your recruiting coach. UB SAT code 2925; UB ACT code 2978	As soon as you apply to UB-- transcripts should be sent early senior year then again immediately after graduation.
<input type="checkbox"/>	*INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS ONLY—submit 1) the copy of your passport picture page; 2) an original bank statement showing sufficient funds to cover the UB cost of attendance 3) an original UB International Admissions financial form	As soon as you apply to UB—you'll receive an email with a username, password and link for "Check my status" where you'll be able to see all the information regarding your admission status.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Send your OFFICIAL high school transcripts from all schools attended and your SAT and/or ACT scores to the NCAA Eligibility Center. *Test scores must be submitted electronically from the testing agency website. NCAA code is 9999.	As soon as possible—transcripts should be sent early senior year then again immediately after graduation.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Finalize your Amateurism status with the NCAA.	After April 1 of your senior year. Log back into your NCAA account and look for the button that reads "Finalize my Amateurism".
<input type="checkbox"/>	Pay your UB tuition deposit online. *Athletes on a full athletic grant in aid will have this deposit waived.	Immediately upon being admitted. http://admissions.buffalo.edu/accepted/steps/index.php
<input type="checkbox"/>	Fill out the UB Housing Application if you're living in the dorms and pay the housing deposit. You can do this at the same time you're paying your tuition deposit.	Immediately upon being admitted—athletes who are housing deferment eligible will receive a UB housing deferment via email after signing the athletic scholarship that should be returned immediately.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Sign up for UB orientation. You will receive an email and link from New Student Programs.	*UB Athletics will conduct an athlete orientation during the days immediately prior to the start of classes in August, however we recommend you attend UB general student orientation, as this is much comprehensive.

<input type="checkbox"/>	Touch base with your UB Academic Advisor to discuss your class schedule, your major and registration.	Your coach will assist you with this. Feel free to email your athletic advisor anytime you have questions about classes. http://www.buffalobulls.com/academic/staff/index
<input type="checkbox"/>	Complete the UB Athletic Training online medical history information. You will be emailed the link and your username and password.	Immediately upon receipt of the email from UB Athletic Training staff—usually in July.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Complete the UB Student Immunization and Health Form record documents and return those documents (fax or mail) to the UB Student Health Office. You'll receive a letter from the Student Health Office with all of the information regarding these documents.	Immediately upon receipt of the letter. *please note—these documents are NOT the same documents from Athletics.
<input type="checkbox"/>	All students are charged for UB Student Health Insurance automatically—you must waive the UB insurance if you do not need it and you have sufficient health insurance coverage. The Student Health Insurance Office will mail you the information regarding this in July.	Immediately upon receipt of the letter. **this is very important. Student Health Insurance is \$1600+ for the year so be sure to follow all of the waiver instructions if you do not need UB's insurance.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Activate your UB Information Technology Account. You need your UBITName, single-use password and person number to claim your UBITName. Your person number was included on your Admissions Acceptance Letter, and your UBITName and single-use password were included on your Admissions Deposit Acknowledgement Letter.	Immediately upon receipt of your UB IT name and person number. http://orientation.buffalo.edu/step2/
