# NINE ADVANCE AS ZONE DIVING CONCLUDES

*George Mason diver wins two events in Saturday's competition*

**BUFFALO, NY** - The NCAA Zone A Diving Qualifying Meet at the University at Buffalo has been completed with nine divers advancing to the National Championships later this month.

Saturday's competitions consisted of women's one-meter and men's three-meter, as well as, men's and women's platform diving. George Mason's Mary Campioli won both women's events earning 512.00 points on the one-meter springboard and 364.80 points from the platform. Drexel's Anthony Perry won the men's three-meter springboard event with 550.95 while Pittsburgh's Dennis Nemtsanov took the men's platform competition with 458.80. Nemtsanov also finished second in the three-meter event at 529.55 points.

Buffalo freshman divers **Patrick Lee (North Tonawanda, NY/North Tonawanda)** and **Ashlee Burton (Franklin, IN/Franklin Community)** also competed in Saturday's events. Lee placed seventh in a 22-diver field in the men's three-meter competition. Burton represented the Bulls in both the one-meter and platform events. She finished 27th among 39 divers on the springboard at 192.10 points and took sixth in a seven-entrant field on the platform with 309.30 points.

Scoring for the women's one-meter competition consisted of entrants attempting six optional dives and, after the field was cut to the top 18, repeating the same six dives in the finals. Both round's scores were then totaled to determine a winner. For the men's three-meter, all divers performed 11 dives. In the platform competition, six optional dives for men and five optionals for the women were followed by four voluntary dives with a maximum degree of difficulty of 7.6. All three levels of the tower, five-, seven- and ten-meter heights, were used in the competition.
