### NENOVA LIFTS UB PAST BSU; ORTMAN BECOMES SINGLES VICTORY LEADER

The University at Buffalo women's tennis team split a week-end roadtrip picking up a hard-fought 4-3 win at Ball State on Saturday after dropping a 6-1 defeat at Bowling Green on Friday. The Bulls are now 6-3 overall and 2-2 in the Mid-American Conference.

A victory by **Miglina Nenova (Rousse, Bulgaria/Eurointellect)** at third singles gave the Bulls the deciding margin against the Cardinals on Saturday. Nenova needed three sets to dispose of Ball State's Haly Calderwood, 7-5, 4-6, 6-2. UB also won three additional singles matches. At first singles, **Andreea Novaceanu (Bucharest, Romania/Emil Racovita)** defeated Jenny Batty, 7-5, 6-1. At fourth singles, **Katrin Fischer (Ternitz, Austria/Borg)** downed Jennifer Pollack, 6-2, 6-2. At sixth singles, **Tina Jacob (Singapore/Raffles JC)** rolled past Katie Owens, 7-5, 6-4.

On Friday, **Kristen Ortman (Amherst, NY/Amherst)** became the women's tennis team's winningest singles player at the Division I level, but it wasn't enough as the Bulls dropped a 6-1 decision to Bowling Green at Keefe Courts. It was the first time this spring that the Bulls had been able to play outdoors although the weather wasn't at an optimal level for competition.

Ortman won her match at third singles over Bowling Green's Andrea Volle, 6-2, 6-0. It was Ortman's 38th win of her career to surpass Stacey Gargan (1994-97) and Annulett Dillon (1995-99), who both posted 37 victories in UB's Division I history. She also became UB's winningest doubles player earlier this season and now has 37 doubles triumphs.

The Bulls return home for a pair of MAC contests this week, hosting Northern Illinois on Friday and Western Michigan on Saturday. Both matches are scheduled for 3:00 pm starts at the Village Glen Tennis Center in Williamsville.
