BULLS FALL IN MAC MATCHES

The University at Buffalo women's tennis team continued competition in its 2002 spring season over the weekend with matches against the University of Toledo and Eastern Michigan University. The Bulls fell 7-0 in both matches.

At first singles against the Rockets, junior **Karen Maynard** (*Poughkeepsie, NY/Spackenkill*) fell to Viviana Rivero, 6-1, 6-1. Freshman **Michaela Kollarova** (*Slovak Republic/Bratislava*) fell at second singles to Monica Ribero, 6-1, 6-0. At third singles, senior **Shani Amarasinghe** (*Patchogue, NY/Patchogue-Medford*) fell to Whitney Wasielewski, 6-0, 6-0. Senior **Jennifer Wong** (*Penfield, NY/Penfield*) fell to Natalya Natyshak at fourth singles, 6-2, 6-3. **Erica Zielinski** (*North Tonawanda, NY/North Tonawanda*) fell at fifth singles to Marivi Cuartin, 6-0, 6-0. At sixth singles, senior **Meaghan Partelow** (*Lyons, NY/Lyons*) was defeated by Eva Szuch, 6-2, 6-2. In doubles competition, **Maynard** and **Kollarova** fell to Ribero and Rivero at number one, 8-1. At second doubles, **Amarasinghe** and **Wong** fell to Wasielewski and Natyshak, 8-0. At third doubles, **Partelow** and **Zielinski** were defeated by Szuch and Cuartin, 8-3.

In competition against the Eagles, **Maynard** fell to Simone Duhme at first singles, 6-1, 6-0. **Kollarova** fell at second singles to Amalia Lincaru, 6-0, 6-1. At third singles, **Amarasinghe** fell to Shari Gamarnik, 6-0, 6-0. **Wong** fell to Kendra Clark at fourth singles, 6-1, 6-1. At fifth singles, **Partelow** was defeated by Julie-Anne Ryan, 6-0, 6-1. **Wendy Rose** (*Eden, NY/Eden*) fell to Marijana Adzic at sixth singles, 6-0, 6-1.

In doubles competition, **Maynard** and **Kollarova** fell to Rebecca Hawkins and Lisa D'Amelio at number one, 8-2. At second doubles, **Amarasinghe** and **Wong** fell to Duhme and Clark, 8-1. At third doubles, **Partelow** and **Zielinski** were defeated by Gamarnik and Lincaru, 8-0.

The Bulls are next in action against Bowling Green State University on Friday, April 19 at 1 pm at the UB Tennis Complex. Saturday, April 20 the Bulls will host their last home match of the season against Ball State. The match begins at 1 pm and will be senior day.
