BULLS FALL AT MARSHALL AND MIAMI

It was a rough weekend for the UB women's tennis team as they fell at Marshall, ranked 67th in the Intercollegiate Tennis Association rankings, on Friday by a 7-0 score and at Miami (OH), 5-2, on Saturday.

Against Marshall, UB's top tandem of **Andreea Novaceanu (Bucharest, Romania/Emil Racovita)** and **Kristen Ortman (Amherst, NY/Amherst)** played well against the country's 60th-ranked duo, Danielle Hock and Joelle Good, but fell by an 8-4 count. In singles play, Novaceanu was the lone Bull to win a set against her opponent. Playing first singles, Novaceanu scored a 6-3 win in the opening set against Ashley Kroh. However, Kroh then took the next two sets, 6-0, 6-2, to win the match.

Marshall, currently second in the MAC with a 6-1 league mark, has now won seven consecutive matches with 7-0 shutouts.

Against Miami, the Bulls had some better luck. UB won the top two singles matches by identical scores. Novaceanu rolled past Linda Jirouskova by a 6-2, 6-2 margin in the number one match. At number two, **Miglena Nenova (Rousse, Bulgaria/Eurointellect)** also posted a 6-2, 6-2 win as she topped Katrina Lomidze.

UB dropped tough three-set matches at third and fourth singles. Ortman won the first set of the number three match against Kelly Douple, 6-2, but lost the next two sets, 6-4, 6-0. At number four, Fischer picked up an opening-set win over Leda Pesatova, 6-3. Pesatova then rallied to win the second set, 6-3, and the deciding set by a 6-0 score.

The Bulls won one of three doubles matches as Novaceanu and **Tina Jacob (Singapore/Raffles JC)** combined to down Pesatova and Douple, 8-4.

UB concludes the regular season on Friday, April 22 at Akron.
