### BULLS FALL IN MAC MATCHES

The University at Buffalo women's tennis team continued competition in its 2002 spring season over the weekend with matches against Bowling Green State University and Ball State University. The Bulls fell 7-0 in both matches.

In competition against the Falcons, junior **Karen Maynard** (*Poughkeepsie, NY/Spackenkill*) fell to Devon Bissinger, 6-2, 6-0 at number one. Freshman **Michaela Kollarova** (*Slovak Republic/ Bratislava*) fell at second singles to Lisa Maloney, 6-2, 6-0. At third singles, senior **Shani Amarasinghe** (*Patchogue, NY/Patchogue-Medford*) fell to Susie Schoenberger, 6-1, 6-0. Senior **Jennifer Wong** (*Penfield, NY/Penfield*) fell to Gaby Coello at fourth singles, 6-1, 6-3. **Erica Zielinski** (*North Tonawanda, NY/North Tonawanda*) fell at fifth singles to Laura Kokinda, 6-3, 6-0. At sixth singles, senior **Meaghan Partelow** (*Lyons, NY/Lyons*) was defeated by Cameron Benjamin, 6-1, 6-1.

In doubles competition, **Maynard** and **Kollarova** fell to Bissinger and Schoenberger at number one, 8-0. At second doubles, **Amarasinghe** and **Wong** fell to Coello and Alyson Gabel, 8-2. At third doubles, **Partelow** and **Zielinski** were defeated by Maloney and Jessica Johnson, 8-1.

Against Ball State, **Maynard** fell at number one to Melissa Roach, 6-0, 6-2. At second singles, **Amarasinghe** fell to Leisa Brooks, 6-3, 6-1. **Wong** fell to Abbie Hodge at third singles, 6-0, 6-1. Senior **Kendra Pyke** (*Watertown, NY/Watertown*) fell at fourth singles to Jenny Batty, 6-0, 6-0. Senior **Anne Schule** (*Snyder, NY/Amherst*) fell at fifth singles to Kara Sullivan, 6-0, 6-1. At sixth singles, **Partelow** was defeated by Susan Kelley, 6-0, 6-0.

In doubles competition, **Maynard** and **Kollarova** fell to Roach and Hodge at number one, 8-0. At second doubles, **Amarasinghe** and **Wong** fell to Brooks and Batty, 8-1. At third doubles, **Partelow** and **Zielinski** were defeated by Jill Wieman and Alyce Zollman, 8-0.

The Bulls are next in action at the Mid-American Conference Championships in DeKalb, IL, on April 24-28.
