## Women's Tennis

### BULLS SWEEP WEEKEND MATCHES

UB's women's tennis team scored a 6-1 win over local rival St. Bonaventure on Saturday and followed with a 5-2 victory over St. Francis on Sunday for an undefeated weekend.

In Saturday's contest, UB scored the doubles point, winning all three matches. The Bulls picked up a victory by default at number three and **Helen Lynch (Hobart, Tasmania/St. Michael's Collegiate)** and **Michaela Kollarova (Bratislava, Slovak Republic/Sport Gymnasium)** won 8-2 at number two over Jennifer Iannone and Kasey Mutzel. The number one match was decided in a 7-4 tiebreaker game with UB's **Karen Maynard (Poughkeepsie, NY/Spackenkill)** and **Kristen Ortman (Amherst, NY/Amherst)** taking the 9-8 win over Michelle Kearney and Natalie Rumpel.

The Bulls then won five of six singles matches to complete the day. Maynard defeated Kearney, 6-3, 6-3, at number one. Ortman downed Iannone, 6-1, 6-1, at number three. Lynch dropped Mutzel, 6-1, 6-2, at number four. **Lisa Wittman (Cheektowaga, NY/Cheektowaga)** breezed past Erin Sullivan, 6-1, 6-0, at number five. UB's **Wendy Rose (Eden, NY/Eden)** won by default at number six. The lone point Bonnies point was scored when Kollarova was forced to default to Rumpel in the number two match.

Sunday, the Bulls returned home to knock off St. Francis at the UB Tennis Center.

Like in Saturday's action, the Bulls opened the match by winning the doubles point. All three UB duos cruised to wins as number one team Maynard and Ortman defeated Amy Croskey and Jamie DeLorie, 8-1. Number two duo Lynch and Kollarova and third team **Sheri Ugowski (Orchard Park, NY/Orchard Park)** and Wittman defeated their Red Flash opponents by identical 8-0 scores.

UB also took four of the six singles matches. Ortman, at number two, downed Lesley Wenzel, 6-0, 6-3. Lynch defeated DeLorie, 6-3, 6-4 at number three. Rose, at number five, defeated Kendra Fewell, 6-2, 6-3, and Ugowski, at number six, defeated Wanschalk, 6-4, 6-2. St. Francis' Croskey defeated Maynard in the number one match, 7-5, 6-4, and UB's Wittman fell to Byrer, 6-1, 6-2, in the number four match.

The Bulls head for the St. Bonaventure Tournament for their next action this Friday through Sunday.
