The University at Buffalo wrestling team will compete in their final dual of the season against in-state rival Binghamton on Sunday afternoon, February 24, at 1:00 p.m. Prior to the match the Bulls will recognize their seniors, **John Cummings, Dana Gingerich, Pat Lloyd, Ryan Needle, Jeff Parker, Mike Ragusa** and **Scott Rendos**, who will be making their final appearance in the blue and white at Alumni Arena.

ABOUT BINGHAMTON

Binghamton comes to Buffalo with a 13-11 dual meet record. Binghamton's last dual was three days ago, on Thursday, February 24 when the Bearcats defeated American University, 26-16. The 13 dual wins represent the the second-highest single-season total in Binghamton wrestling history. Nate Patterson at 157 pounds has the best individual record among the Bearcats, Patterson is 23-11 this season.

LAST TIME OUT

EDINBORO, PA – Mickey Moran scored a 3-1 overtime victory over 16th-ranked Chris Honeycutt, but it wasn't enough as the University at Buffalo wrestling team fell at #14 Edinboro, 37-3. Buffalo now stands at 8-7-1 on the season.

Moran's victory was a bright spot in an otherwise difficult night for the Bulls, as UB lost the other nine matches in the dual, with four of those losses coming to nationally-ranked wrestlers.

Edinboro opened up the dual with two major decision victories and a pinfall within the first three matches, giving the Fighting Scots an early 14-0 advantage. The Scots' lead reached 17-0 with Daryl Coccozzo's 10-5 decision victory over **Ryan Needle** at 149 pounds.

In the fifth match of the evening, **John Cummings** was matched up against the nation's top-ranked 157-pound wrestler, and defending national champion, Gregor Gillespie. Gillespie won the bout by technical fall, 18-0.

Edinboro followed with two more nationally-ranked wrestlers at 165 and 174 pounds. At 165, 15th-ranked Jarrod King earned a victory over **Scott Rendos** when Rendos was forced to injury default at 6:16. Phil Moricone, the 18th-ranked wrestler in the nation at 174 pounds, then won a tight 3-0 decision over **Mike Ragusa**.

Moran then earned the lone win of the night for UB when he took down Honeycutt, the nation's 16th-ranked 184-pounder. Moran and Honeycutt battled to a 1-1 score through regulation time, as each earned an escape point. But in the overtime Moran scored a takedown with 25 seconds remaining to score the upset win. The victory improved Moran's record to 29-7 on the season.

Edinboro's Pat Bradshaw answered with a tight 4-3 decision victory over **Jimmy Hamel** at 197 pounds and 19th-ranked Joey Fendone finished the dual with a 3-0 victory for Edinboro over **Jeff Parker**.

Atlantic Regional Top 20. Moran is the highest-ranking Bull, slotted in at #14 at 184 pounds. Hamel is ranked 17th at 197 pounds, while Stella and Ragusa are both ranked 20th, at 141 and 174 pounds respectively.

HAMEL FINISHES MAC DUALS 4-1

With his 5-1 overtime victory over Kent State's Michael Blackwell, redshirt freshman **Jimmy Hamel** finished Mid-American Conference dual meets with a 4-1 record at 197 pounds. Hamel's only loss in a MAC dual meet came to Central Michigan's Wynn Michalak, currently the fourth-ranked 197 pound wrestler in the nation. Hamel is ranked second in the latest MAC rankings, released February 13.

THREE CURRENT BULLS AMONG ALL-TIME ESCAPE LEADERS

Three members of the current UB roster, **Pat Lloyd**, **Andrew Stella** and **Jeff Parker** rank among the top 20 in escapes in UB history. Lloyd is currently second with 70 career escapes, nine behind the all-time leader Mark Crays (1988-91). Stella, with 56 career escapes, is currently 11th all-time. Parker is the latest UB grappler to join the list, tied for 20th with 48 career escapes. **Mike Ragusa** sits just outside the top 20 all-time with 47 career escapes. MORAN CROWNED NEW YORK STATE CHAMPION

In the 184-pound weight class, junior **Mickey Moran** earned New York State Championship honors, becoming the 59th individual New York State Champion in UB history. Moran went 4-0 during the New York State Championships, winning the 184-pound crown with a 3-1 tie-breaker victory over Nate Holley of Cornell.

PARKER GOES 3-0 AT MICHIGAN DUALS

Senior **Jeff Parker** registered a perfect 3-0 record at the Michigan Duals. In his first match, Parker was awarded an injury default win over Michigan's Matt Guhn at 4:11. He followed that up with a 5-2 decision over Justin Allen of Lehigh and ended the day by picking up his first MAC dual victory of the season, a 5-2 decision over David Wade of Eastern Michigan.

39 TOTAL PLACEWINNERS

In six tournaments this season, Buffalo has recorded a total of 39 place-winning performances. Two Bulls, **Jimmy Hamel** and **Mickey Moran**, have placed at a team-high five events. Hamel has one victory, at Mat Town, and two second place finishes, as well as a fourth and a fifth. Moran has three titles, at the UB Open, Mat Town and the New York State Collegiate Championship, a third place finish and a fourth place finish.

HAMEL WINS FIRST COLLEGIATE TOURNAMENT

Redshirt freshman **Jimmy Hamel** won his first tournament as a college wrestler at the Mat Town Tournament. Hamel, wrestling at 197 pounds, won three matches to earn his first title. In his opening bout, Hamel defeated Josh White of Lock Haven by a 17-7 decision. Hamel took down Raymond Bennett of Millersville in the semifinals by a 13-3 decision. In the final, he defeated Nick Sommerfeld of Columbia to take the 197-pound crown.

GINGERICH'S PIN PARTY CONTINUES

Buffalo senior **Dana Gingerich** picked up another victory via pinfall at the Las Vegas Invitational, a 46 second triumph over Sam Allen of Utah Valley State. With two victories in Las Vegas, Gingerich now has 20 total wins, 10 of which have come via pinfall.

TWO BULLS CROWNED CHAMPIONS, AGAIN

For the second time this season, UB had two wrestlers win their weight classes at the same tournament. **Mickey Moran** and **Jimmy Hamel** won the 184 and 197 pound weight classes, respectively, at the Mat Town Tournament. Earlier this year, Moran and **Mike Ragusa** both took home titles at the UB Open.

GINGERICH NAMED MAC WRESTLER OF THE WEEK

Following his second place finish at the Body Bar Invitational, Buffalo senior **Dana Gingerich** was named Mid-American Conference wrestler of the week. Gingerich won his first three bouts in the 149 pound weight class before fall in the final to Eric Medina of Maryland. Gingerich concluded the Body Bar Invitational with a 12-3 overall record.

BULLS POST BEST-EVER FINISH AT OKLAHOMA GOLD

The University at Buffalo wrestling team fought their way to the best team finish ever for UB at the Oklahoma Gold Classic. The Bulls finished the event in second place, behind only 19th-ranked Oklahoma. Six Buffalo wrestlers earned placement finishes, led by **Dana Gingerich** who finished second at 149 pounds.

TWO BULLS CROWNED CHAMPIONS

Two Bulls, senior **Mike Ragusa** and junior **Mickey Moran** won their respective weight classes at the fifth annual UB Open. Ragusa won the event at 174 pounds, winning four matches by a combined score of 62-19 and Moran took the title at 184 pounds, also winning four matches en route to the crown.

BACK-TO-BACK FOR RAGUSA

For senior **Mike Ragusa**, his championship at the UB Open marked the second-straight year that he opened the season with a victory in the event. Last year Ragusa won the UB Open at 165 pounds, this year his title came at 174.

GINGERICH PINS FOUR AT UB OPEN

Senior **Dana Gingerich** recorded four fall at the 2007 UB Open. Gingerich opened the event with a pin fall victory over Chris Lascari of Clarion at 1:24. He picked up his second fall in his third match at 4:10 over Aaron Parks of Alfred. Then in wrestleback action he finished the UB Open with two pins, over Zack McKendree of Gannon and Kyle John of Maryland, to place third in the competition at 149 pounds.

12 BULLS PLACE AT UB OPEN

A total of 12 Buffalo wrestlers finished in the top six in their individual weight classes at the season-opening UB Open. Two Bulls, **Mickey Moran** and **Mike Ragusa**, won their weight classes at the event. Three more Bulls finished in second place, **John Cummings**, **Jimmy Hamel** and **Jeff Parker**. Also placing for UB were: **Dan Bishop**, **Dana Gingerich**, **Tom Graff**, **Corey Greene**, **Justin Hunt**, **Robert Rhyal** and **Jason Weber**.

UB NAMES A PAIR OF CAPTAINS FOR 2007-08

A pair of Bulls will represent the UB wrestling team as captains this season, they are junior **Mickey Moran** and senior **Jeff Parker**. After redshirting last season, Moran will lead the Bulls at 184 pounds while Parker will headline the UB roster at 285.

BUFFALO INKS FOUR TO 2008-09 CLASS

Head coach Jim Beichner announced that four wrestlers, **John Martin Cannon**, **Christopher Conti**, **Mark Lewandowski** and **Ron Majerus**, have signed National Letters of Intent to wrestle for the Bulls beginning in 2008-09. All four were placewinners last year at the New York State High School Wrestling Championships.

13th Season

116-80-3 Overall Record

For the fourth time under the guidance of Jim Beichner, a Buffalo wrestler reached the 100-win plateau. Mark Budd joined Kyle Cerminara, Gary Cooper and Josh States as the only Bulls to reach that prestigious mark, all have done so since Beichner took the reigns at UB.

During Beichner's tenure, the Bulls' wrestling program has undergone a complete turnaround. In 12 seasons, Beichner has guided Buffalo to a 108-73-2 (.601) dual meet record and has coached 26 Bulls at the NCAA Championships.

Beichner arrived at UB for the 1995-96 season, and guided the Bulls to a 10-4 dual meet record after going winless the previous season. The Bulls captured third place in the East Coast Wrestling Association (ECWA) Tournament and sent two wrestlers to the NCAA Championships where they each posted wins, the first-ever tournament wins for UB since its return to Division I. Additionally, coach Beichner was recognized for his efforts, receiving the New York State Division I and ECWA Coach of the Year awards, in addition to Amateur Wrestling News Rookie Coach of the Year honors.

In his second season, Beichner guided the team to a 12-2-2 record, the most wins in over a decade for the program. Again the Bulls finished third at the ECWA Tournament. Jason Wartinger qualified for the NCAA Championships for the third time in his career. In addition, the Bulls finished in the top five in all five tournaments they participated in under Beichner's leadership.

In his third season, UB finished in third place at the ECWA Tournament. In addition, the Bulls made another step towards national prominence by sending three qualifiers to the NCAA National Championships, the third consecutive year Beichner had guided wrestlers to the NCAA Championships.

In addition to the team's success, Beichner helped the UB program and the Western New York area by bringing the National Wrestling Coaches Association All-Star Classic to UB's Alumni Arena. This national tournament showcased some of the top wrestlers in the country at each weight class going against each other as a preview of possible National Championship matchups. All told, there were six National Champions and 19 All-Americans from that season who competed at UB's Alumni Arena.

In 1998-99, Beichner continued the program's upward climb as the Bulls entered the Mid-American Conference, a conference that had two teams finish in the top 10 at the NCAA Championships the previous year. UB finished third in the regular season and fourth at the MAC Championships. Additionally, the Bulls had three qualifiers for the NCAA Championships for the second straight season.

During the 1999-2000 season, Buffalo finished with an 11-5 dual meet record. Within the MAC, the Bulls posted a 2-3 mark leaving them in fourth place. UB also placed fourth at the MAC Championships. Once again, three of Buffalo's wrestlers qualified for the NCAA Championships.

In the 2000-01 campaign under Beichner, four UB wrestlers qualified for the NCAA Championships. Buffalo's lone NCAA qualifier in 2001-02 was freshman standout Kyle Cerminara.

In 2002-03 - along with Labe Black and Gary Cooper reaching the NCAA Championships - Beichner's team went 9-6 and won the New York State Collegiate Championships.

In 2003-04, Beichner led the Bulls to an 8-0 dual meet start on the way to a 12-5 season. Along the way, Buffalo took second at the New York State Collegiate Championships and Ed Pawlak, McKnight and Cerminara won MAC Championships to earn bids to the NCAA Championships.

Though McKnight and Pawlak bowed out in the All-American round at the meet, Cerminara won in overtime en route to an eighth-place finish. UB finished 33rd at the meet, its highest placing in the Division I era.

Head coach Jim Beichner's team went through a youth movement in 2004-05, with four freshmen being placed in the starting lineup and two sophomores and a junior without consistent starting experience also making the starting 10. The result was a season that saw the Bulls struggle to 3-10 in dual meets, but a season that ended with two wins, including a come-from-behind 18-16 win against Kent State.

Even with the youth, Beichner delivered an NCAA qualifier for the 10th consecutive year, as Mark McKnight reached the tournament and a record five Bulls

placed at the Mid-American Conference Championships.

In 2005-06, Beichner's patience paid off, as the team placed a school-record third at the MAC Championships, led by the individual title efforts of captains Mark Budd and Harold Sherrell. Captain Kyle Cerminara also earned a bid to the NCAA Championships, as the 197-pounder posted a UB-best ranking of second in the final NWCA poll and earned the second seed at the NCAA Championships. Budd also earned a national ranking during the season, egged on by his stunning upset of the nation's No. 1-ranked 133-pounder in December.

The rest of the Bulls also got on the winning track, as Mickey Moran went from seven wins as a freshman to 26 and a national ranking as a sophomore, helping the team garner its first national ranking, reaching 24th in the WrestlingReport.com poll.

Despite dealing with numerous injuries, Beichner still guided the 2006-07 Bulls to a winning dual meet record. The Bulls also had success during tournaments throughout the season, as 10 UB wrestlers won tournament titles during the season. The Bulls finished 3rd at the New York State Wrestling Championships and Mark Budd made his second-straight trip to the NCAA Championship.

In his first 12 years, Beichner has made a tremendous impact at the University at Buffalo. He has taken the program from a team with a combined six wins in the four years prior to his arrival to 50 wins in his first five seasons. With 108 dual meet wins, Beichner ranks behind only Ed Michael's 213 career wins at Buffalo.

Beichner and his staff have brought some of the best that collegiate wrestling has to offer to the Western New York area and continue to build a program that is making trips to the NCAA Championships on a regular basis.

Prior to his appointment at UB, Beichner served seven years as an assistant coach at the University of Pittsburgh under head coach Rande Stottlemeyer. At Pittsburgh, Beichner was heavily involved in the day-to-day operations of the program, budgeting, and other administrative duties in addition to his coaching and recruiting responsibilities.

"I was fortunate that Rande gave me the freedom to do what was necessary to get the job done," Beichner commented. "He never put restrictions on my methods, but instead made everything accessible to me at all times."

During his seven-year tenure as an assistant, the Panthers were ranked in the National Top 25 six times, reaching as high as 13th in 1988. During Beichner's last season as an assistant in 1994-95, Pittsburgh was invited to the National Duals Tournament for the first time in school history. En route to an eighth-place finish, the Panthers defeated traditional wrestling powers Oregon State and Arizona State, as well as intrastate rival Penn State for the first time in 19 years.

Beichner's coaching career began at Clarion University following an outstanding collegiate wrestling career for the Golden Eagles. During his four years, Beichner was twice an NCAA Division I All-American at 190 pounds, recorded 125 career victories (tied for third all-time in Clarion history), was twice selected to wrestle in the prestigious East-West All-Star Classic and posted three undefeated dual meet seasons. In addition to captaining Clarion to only its third undefeated dual meet season in more than 38 years of competition, Beichner is 11th in career dual meet wins with 49 and posted the third-best single-season record in school history at 40-4 during the 1984-85 season. In May of 2000, Beichner was inducted into the Clarion Sports Hall of Fame.

It was while coaching at Clarion following his wrestling career that Beichner learned the inner workings of a collegiate wrestling program from one of the winningest coaches in history, Bob Bubb. Currently the Executive Director of the National Wrestling Coaches Association, Bubb had a profound influence on Beichner and his coaching style.

"Coach Bubb was a very regimented coach who ran a strict program," Beichner says. "However, he was more than just a wrestling coach in that he was always there if you were having problems or needed any kind of help. If I can do anything here at UB, I'd like to emulate the way he ran his program and be as successful as he's been."

Beichner began his association with wrestling at Cassadaga Valley High School, located 80 miles southwest of Buffalo. Wrestling under head coach Cliff Blum, Beichner was a three-time New York State High School Tournament place-winner and an inductee into the Cassadaga Hall of Fame in 1982.

"I consider coach Blum to be one of the best coaches I've ever worked with. The majority of my wrestling technique and all the things I've accomplished come as a result of his wrestling program."

In 2004, he was also inducted into the Chautauqua County Hall of Fame for his efforts at Cassadaga Valley, Clarion and UB.

Beichner and his wife Diane have three children - Jake (15), Sam (14), and Grace (8).
